MLK Health Center & Pharmacy provides free healthcare to uninsured and underinsured adults struggling with chronic diseases. We practice people-centered healthcare that focuses on the needs of the whole person. Our patient care teams include physicians, nurse practitioners, dietitians, pharmacists, and support staff. MLK Health is a privately funded health center that received funding from grants, cash contributions, and in-kind donations.

Accomplishments

- We provided 5,929 individual primary and supportive services (care coordination, women's health services, lab services, education services, and provider services), valued at \$609,369.
- We dispensed 17,816 30-day prescriptions, valued at \$1,420,599.52.
- Our volunteers invested 1,443 hours in service to our community, valued at \$88,079.25
